2025 BRITISH HISTORICAL DRAMA FILM CO-PRODUCED AND DIRECTED BY NICHOLAS HYTNER AND WRITTEN BY ALAN BENNETT. SET IN 1916, DURING WORLD WAR I, IN THE FICTIONAL TOWN OF RAMSDEN, YORKSHIRE, THE FILM FOLLOWS THE MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL CHORAL SOCIETY WHICH RECRUITS A DISPARATE GROUP OF TOWNSPEOPLE FOR A PERFORMANCE OF EDWARD ELGAR'S THE DREAM OF GERONTIUS, A WORK CHOSEN BECAUSE IT WAS NOT WRITTEN BY A GERMAN.

KEIRA KNIGHTLEY STARS AS ELIZABETH BENNET, WHILE MATTHEW MACFADYEN PLAYS MR DARCY, WHO FALLS IN LOVE WITH HER.
